WHAT IS IT?

A grant that provides funding statewide to support child abuse prevention programs and family advocacy centers across Arizona.

HOW IS IT HELPING?

Since its establishment in 1999, over \$10 million in grant funding has been awarded to community partners focused on child abuse awareness, education, and prevention efforts.



IN 2024, \$100K IN GRANT FUNDING WAS AWARDED TO FOUR ORGANIZATIONS TO SUPPORT CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION PROGRAMS.

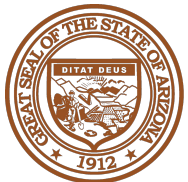

3. May be personalized with a max of 7 characters

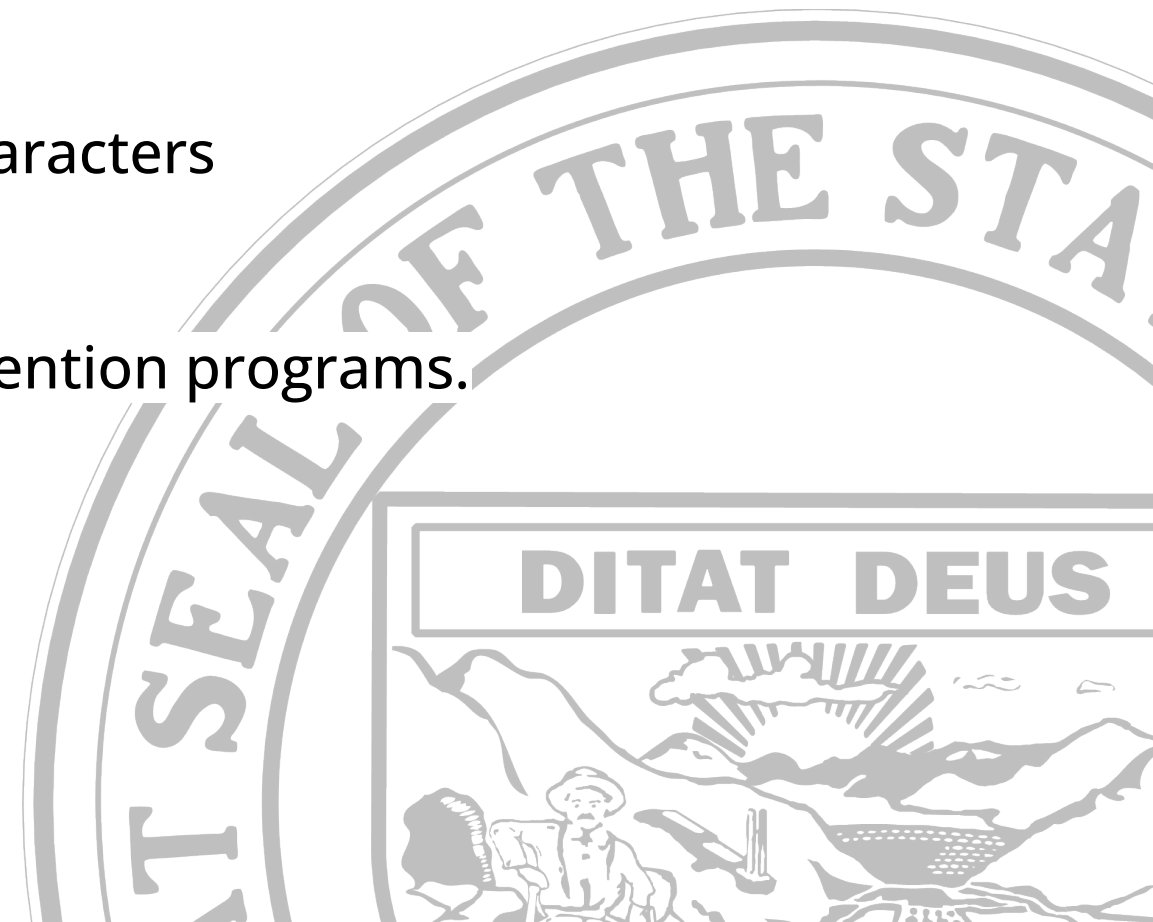
Also available with a disability symbol.

\$100,000 was awarded to **four** Arizona organizations whose programming focuses on child abuse and neglect prevention. Began on July 1, 2024.

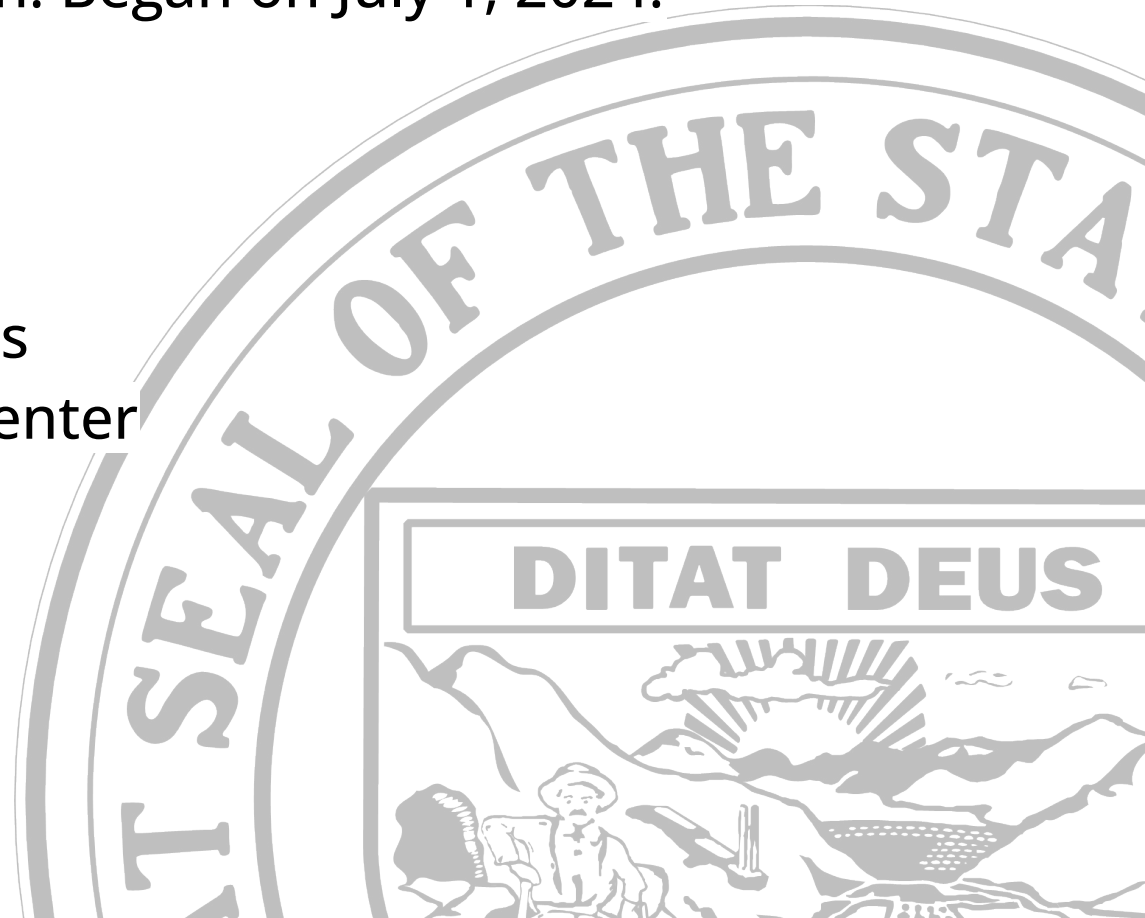

Funding Amounts

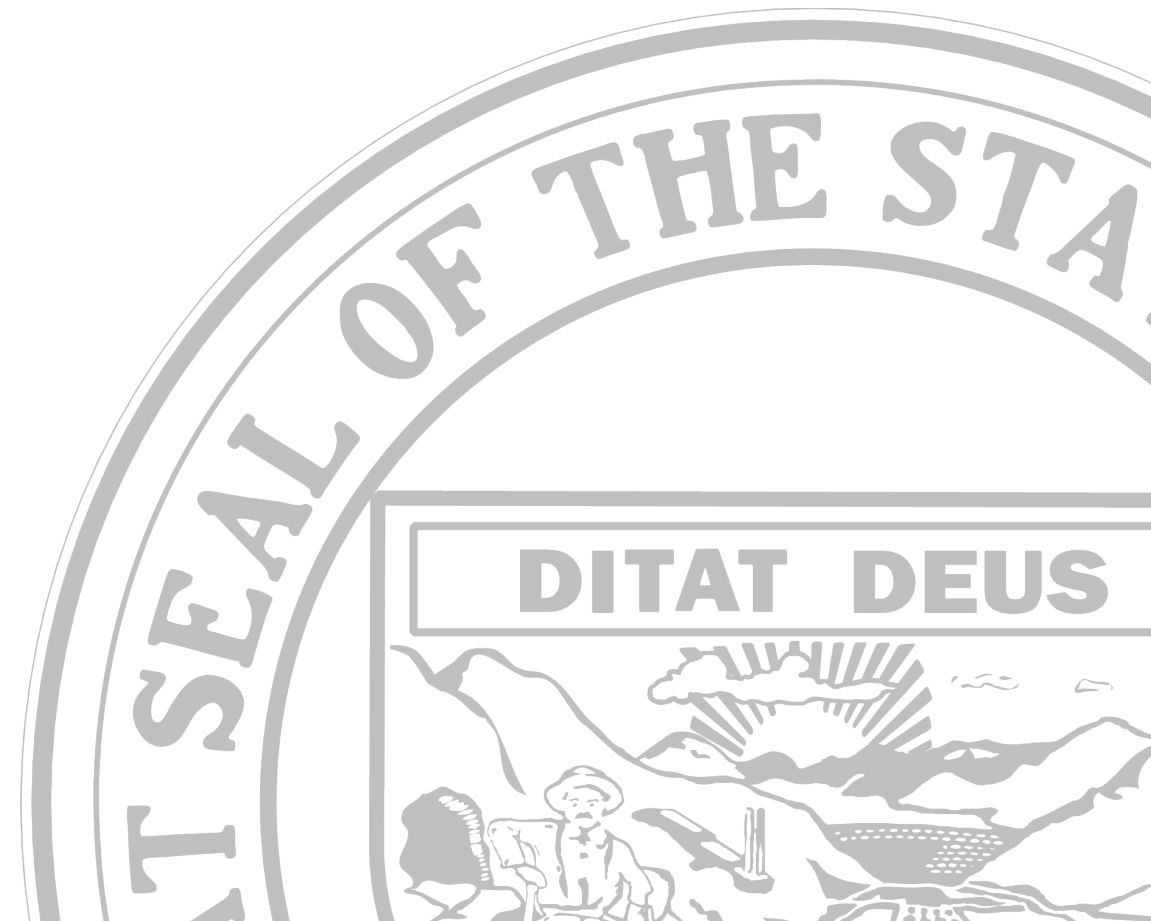
Since GOYFF acquired the program in 2019, the fund has decreased by **75%**.
