The largest Doctoral Psychology Internship program in the United States.



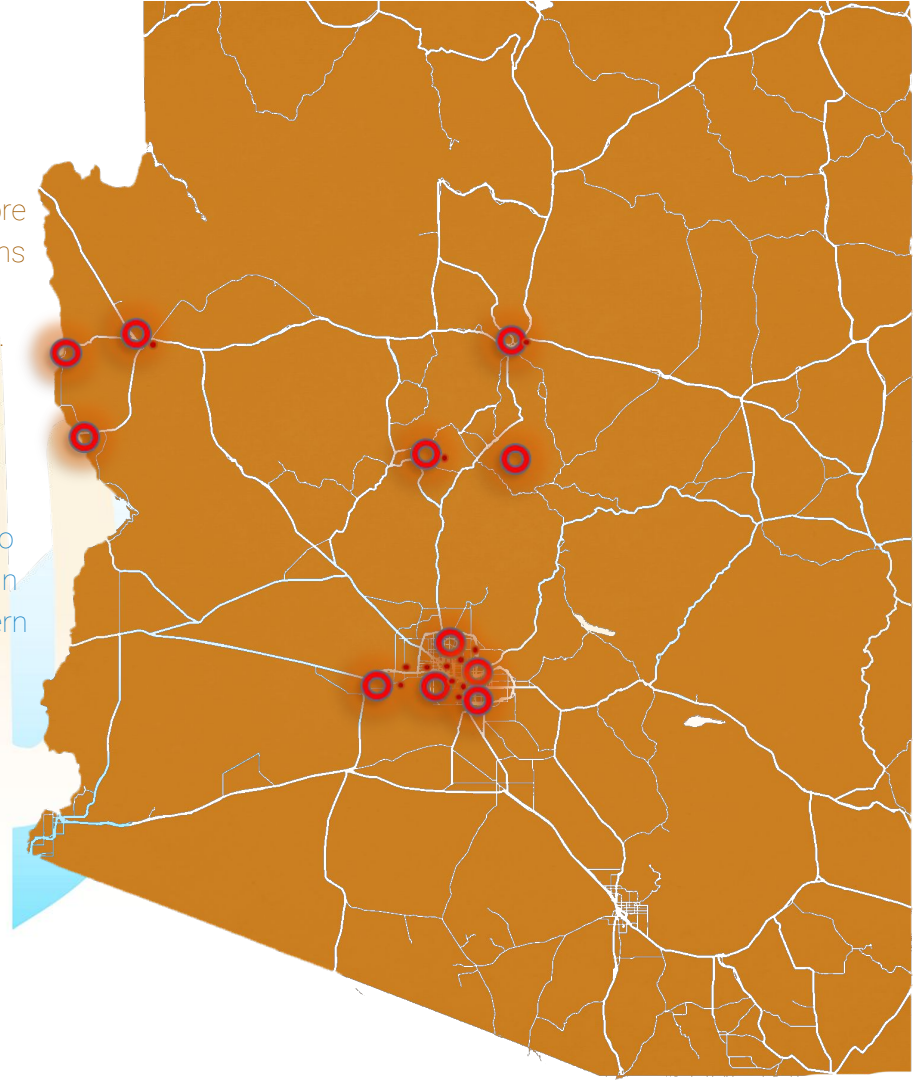
Provide services to over 200 schools in Central and Northern Arizona.

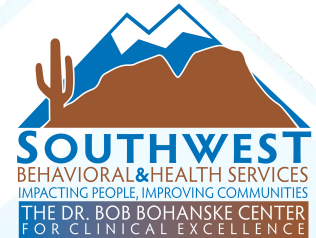
Outcome Informed
